



## **Mount Signal / El Cerro del Centinela is part of the Imperial and the Mexicali Valley histories for many reasons**

The historical content of “Mount Signal” is made of a various ethnicities with different cultures that arrived a long time ago to the Imperial and Mexicali Valleys. “Mount Signal” is located in Baja California, Mexico. Some of the ethnic groups that I mention are the Spaniards, the Cucupa Indigenous, and the Chinese. The history of “Mount Signal” relates back to the past time when the Spaniards came to America and they were looking for path ways to explore the land. The Cucupa Indigenous are an Indian group located in the Mexican side and they are dedicated to hunting, fishing and agriculture. The Chinese people came to the Mexicali Valley with plans to immigrate to the United States.
