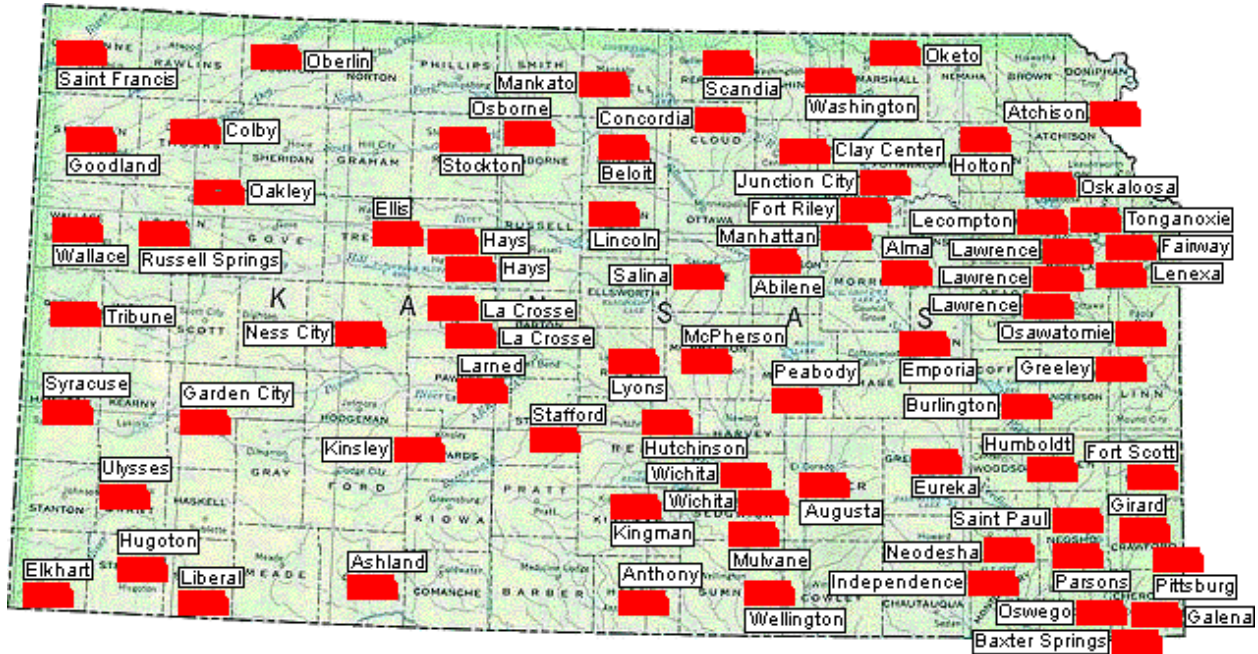


Topographical Models of the State of Kansas

Each model is approximately 4 x 11 x 27 inches, made from cast Hydrostone, and coated with white primer.

Around seventy-five of these models were made during the summer of 2003 to be donated to regional historical society museums throughout the state of Kansas. The models were delivered to the museums personally.
