

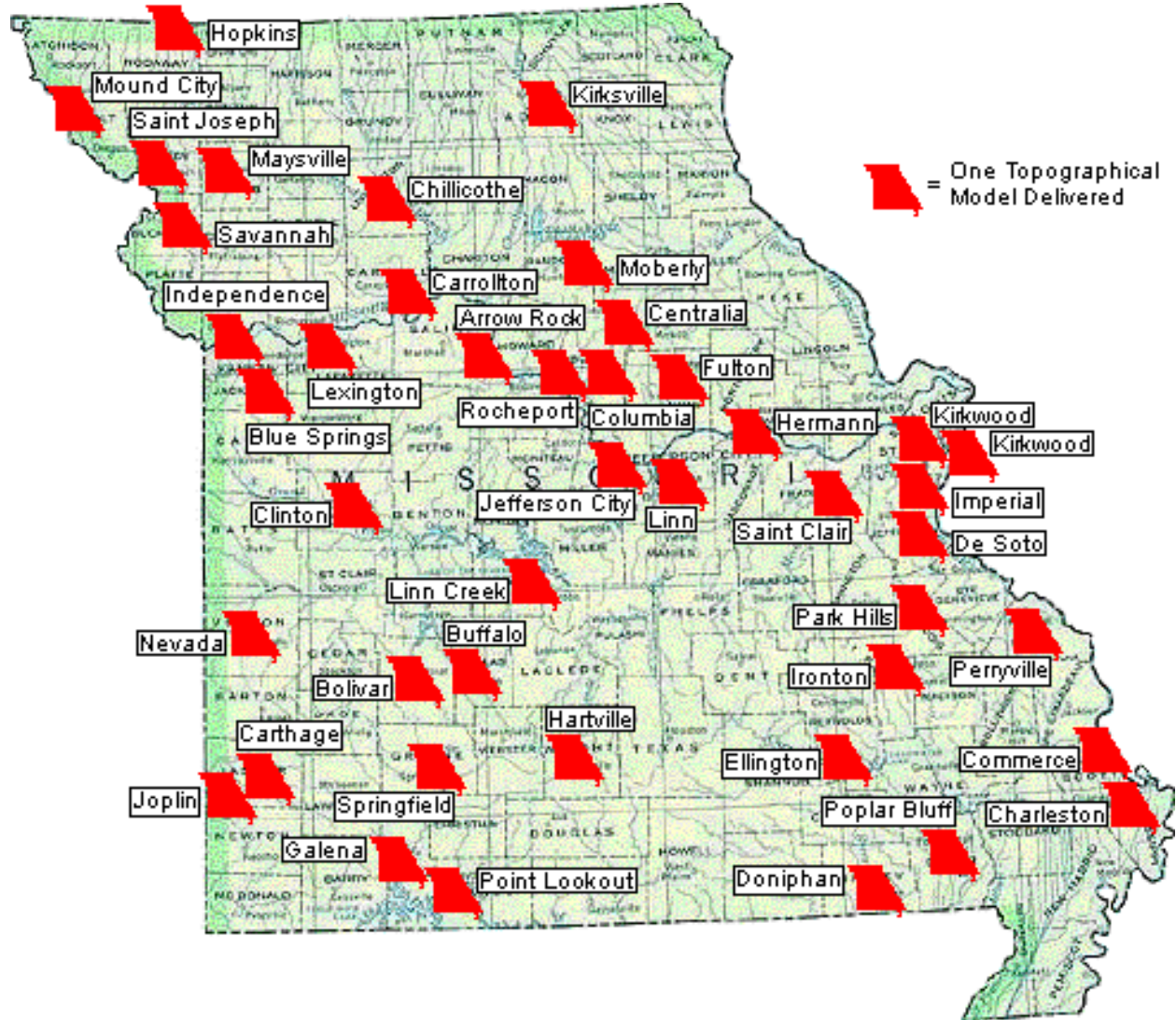


Topographical Models of the State of Missouri

Each model is approximately 3 x 23 x 17 inches, made from cast Hydrostone, and coated with white primer.

Around fifty of these models were made during the summer of 2003 to be donated to regional historical society museums throughout the state of Missouri. The models were delivered to the museums personally.
